May I take this opportunity to thank all the Children, Parents and Staff for making our first week, so successful. The children looked so smart in their school uniforms and they are a credit to all of us.

Thank you for parking and entering the drop-off points in the correct way. New signage has been ordered and we look forward to seeing this in action.

It has been a pleasure to meet and great everyone in the mornings and after school. This seems to be working really well. If it is wet, we will open the gates so you can shelter under the EYFS covering within the outdoor area. School opening times in the morning are 8.50am and the gates will open at 8.45am. Children can be collected at 3.15pm and the gates will be opened at 3.10pm.

Sunrise and Sunset Clubs Before and After school wrap around care:

Before and after school wrap around clubs seem to be working and operating well. Thank you to all of you who have chosen to use this facility. Sunrise Club starts at 7.45am and Sunset Club is 3.15pm until 5.30pm. If you wish to use this facility you can collect booking forms from the school office.

New School – Building Update

The tarmac at the front of the school should have or will shortly be completed, making the front of the school look much better.

The lighting and school name has been repaired and is all working correctly now.

We will have some work done to the carpark entrance of the school shortly which will involve some digging of the ground and remedial work allowing our electrical cables to be capped and finalised.

Snagging will continue throughout the year and we may have trades people supervised on and off the site throughout this period. The majority of works will be carried out when there are no children in school.

All Local Governing Bodies should then aim to have at least 12 governors in position; that is to say that the operational minimum

should be 12 governors.



We will share with you the makeup of our governing body as soon as it has been established, introducing you to the governing body. This will then be place upon our school website.
