There will be one teacher, Miss Frearson, and members of the support staff providing additional support. As the numbers of children within the class and within Key Stage 2 grows, the class will be supported by additional teaching staff, who we will employ. This will allow us the flexibility to provide smaller pupil to teacher class ratios. We will keep you informed of any developments as the school and development continues to grow.
