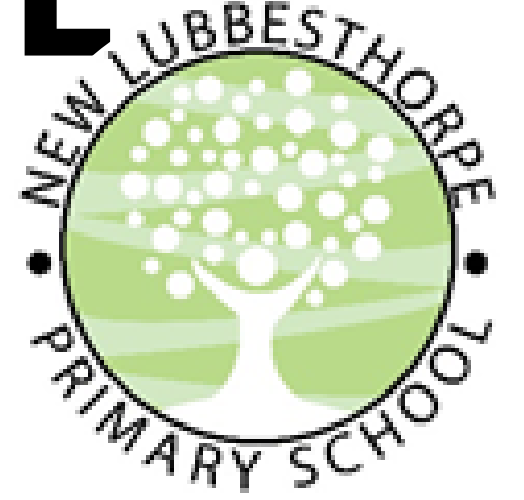


# NEW LUBBESTHORPE PRIMARY SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

## *Message from Miss Hackett*

I would like to congratulate all of the children in Year 6 for how well they have been working during the SATS tests last week. Year two pupils have started to work on their assessments and are approaching each day with confidence, which absolutely shows how hard they have all been working this year.

We are all so proud of all of our children, their approach to learning and behaviour is exemplary. All of the children have earned their Silver Award for following the diamond rules each day.

We will be celebrating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee on Thursday 26th May at New Lubbesthorpe. Children are asked to come to school in sports clothes with a red, white, or blue top. Children will mark the seventy years of the Queen's reign with a dance workshop with iconic styles from each of the decades.

Our year groups will learn 50s juke-box, bop & jive then 60s locomotion, mashed potato and the twist! We move on to 70s disco and line dances, then 80s break dancing, rock & roll and vogueing, 90s hip hop and zumba and into the 2000s with electro pop and modern dance. We will be inviting professional dancers to lead each class. Bringing the music and movement of our recent cultural evolution to life, and celebrating Queen Elizabeth II's Platinum Jubilee. The children will also be having a special Jubilee lunch, with many other activities planned throughout the school day.
