Spring feels like it is finally here and it has been lovely to see the sun shining! It has been great to see children getting outside more and enjoying our wonderful grounds. We enjoyed

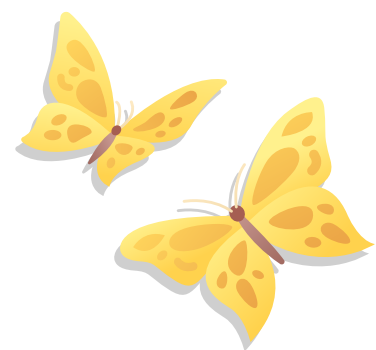

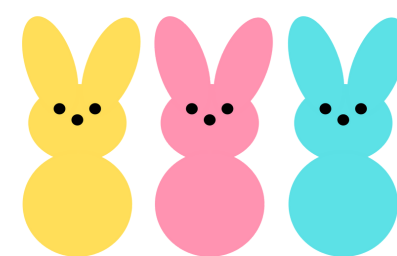
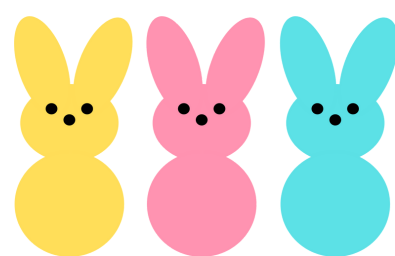
We would like to welcome Mrs Smith to our school office team as our school admin assistant. We hope you will all make Mrs Smith very welcome in her new role!
